From your selections, we will choose the top 17 requested songs and air them as a special program in December, 2017.



## Featured Recipe Broccoli-Cabbage Salad

4 cups broccoli, chopped 4 cups cabbage, chopped 1 small red onion 1/2 - 3/4 cup apple, diced 1/2 - 3/4 cup cranberries (could use more) 1/2 - 3/4 cup carrot, grated Walnuts or slivered almonds, (added just before serving)

#### Dressing:

1 cup mayonnaise or Veganniase 1/2 lemon, juiced Honey, sugar or stevia (to sweeten)
